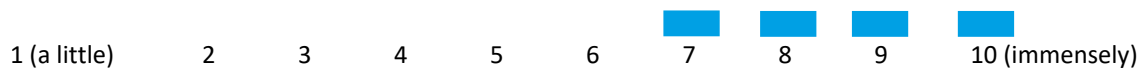

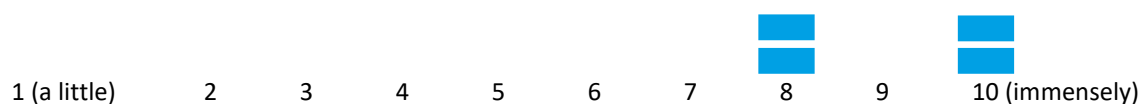
How much do you feel the Highway Code session has increased your knowledge and understanding of the constraints that can impact on shared services/collaborative transformation?

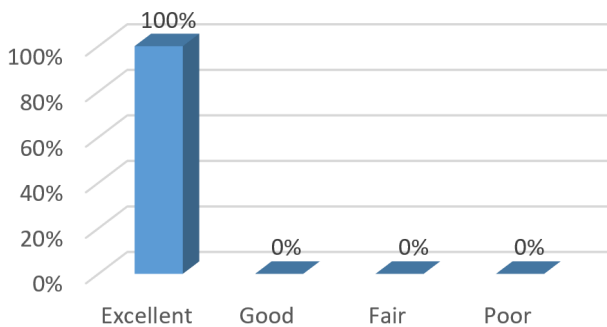

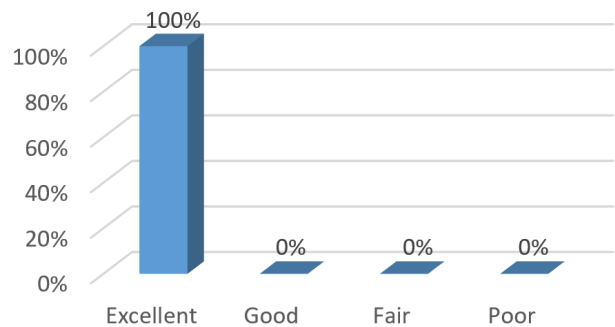
