

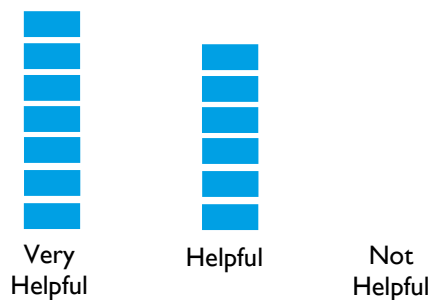
# Collaborative Leadership Across Communities

## Who attended?

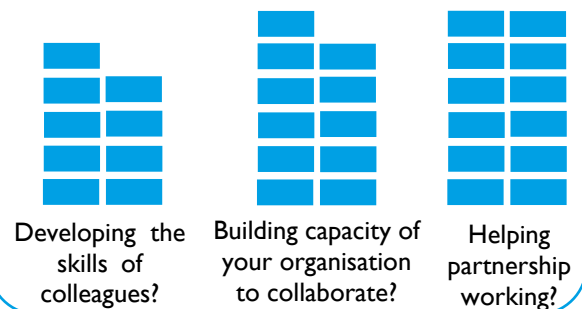
- 13 delegates from West Berkshire Council
